Data Review (15 minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Absenteeism: Standley Middle is still ranked # 1 in the district and cluster in terms of highest student attendance (regardless of holiday season, flus, and COVID). Still at 97.94% attendance & currently at 7% for chronic absenteeism (6 or > school days). Total of 58 students with six or > absent days.• Suspension: 1.5% (13 out of 138 kids).• Budget Survey: This year, there is a 10% increase in budget response rate (BRR). Last year BRR was 20%, this year BRR is 30%.<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Budget survey meetings were held with the ELAC committee, SGT committee, staff, community, & PTSA.- Budget survey results: were shared with SSC members. Results from the community show high priority in mental health support & math support. Results from the school staff show high priority areas in tutoring, tech/equipment, software license & instructional materials. <p><i>Suggested budget priorities (suggestions from SGT, ELAC, staff & community) was reviewed, discussed, and approved.</i></p>	Informational

4. SPSA (5 minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SPSA Timeline Review: Approved SPSA goals for this year, and the budget matches SPSA goals. 	Information/ Discussion

Budget (20 minutes)	<p>24/25 Budget Review and approval:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title I funds: (provided federally if 40% or more of students attending school come from families who are qualified for free/reduced lunch). Standley middle qualifies for title I funds this year (42% free/reduced lunch). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Title 1 is year to year but minimum a two-year program. The school has to be at least 35% free/reduced lunch to get grandfathered in for the second year. - How is title I spent? a minimum of 10% has to go to professional development (PD), then tutoring support, counsellor, the rest is used for students in target groups (ELs, free lunch, etc.) but can be used for all students if the target groups are supported. • Discretionary: Dollars per student enrolled. • LCFF funds: Received from state, based on student enrollement. • VAPA: State prop 28 funds arts, music, choir, drama (50% of budget will be used so as not to over-spend until final release by the state) • Staffing allocation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Full time equivalency (FTE): 31.4 FTEs (5 periods each and 2 extra sections) -Non-teachers: office staff stable cause staff is stable. All stays same for next year. -SpED staff: Ed Specialists will increase from 5.6 FTE to 5.8 FTE. Standley will maintain a moderate and severe classroom (only middle school in the cluster so must maintain class). - ESSER funds: They have expired after COVID-19 have expired and will be picked up by the district.] <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Title 1 budget 30106, 30100 VOTE: LC made a motion to approve the budget for resource 30106 and 30100, YN seconded the motion, the motion was approved unanimously by SSC.
