4. Data Review (15 minutes)	 Absenteeism: Standley Middle is still ranked # 1 in the district and cluster in terms of highest student attendance (regardless of holiday season, flus, and COVID). Still at 97.94% attendance & currently at 7% for chronic absenteeism (6 or > school days). Total of 58 students with six or > absent days. Suspension: 1.5% (13 out of 138 kids). Budget Survey: This year, there is a 10% increase in budget response rate (BRR). Last year BRR was 20%, this year BRR is 30%. Budget survery meetings were held with the ELAC committee, SGT committee, staff, community, & PTSA. Budget survery results: were shared with SSC members. Results from the community show high priority in mental healths support & math support. Results from the school staff show high priority areas in tutoring, tech/equiments, software licence & instructional materials.
